Philadelphia Chinatown Development Corporation organized a District Attorney Candidates' forum for Asian Americans in collaboration with the Mayor's Commission on Asian American Affairs. The event was hosted at the new home of the Asian Arts Initiative (1219 Vine Street) on April 7th. The candidates offered a number of solutions to quelling crime in the city. Some suggested assigning D.A.'s geographically to communities. Other solutions focused on getting guns off the streets. This forum was an exchange of concerns and ideas between Asian Americans and the candidates.
