Chinatown Bell Dedicated at 10th Street Plaza

On May 14th, Chinatown's "Liberty Bell" dedication was held at the 10th Street Plaza. Chinatown's bell, called "It Takes a Village," was created by artists [Chenlin Cai](#) and [Xingzi Liang](#) as part of "Bells Across PA" with America250PA, Mural Arts Philadelphia, and community partner PCDC.

The bell's design celebrates the history of Chinatown, the contributions of immigrant communities to our nation's history, and a nod to the Year of the Horse with a Tang Dynasty horse relief.

Spotlighting Mental Health Awareness and AANHPI Heritage Month

Mental Health Awareness Month:

May is Mental Health Awareness Month, a time for highlighting mental well-being. Just like physical health, mental health is key in students' lives. Throughout the month, our social and emotional learning (SEL) workshops will focus on encouraging students to reflect on their emotions and support one another.

Students will be encouraged to practice self-care in meaningful ways, whether that's taking a break, learning in workshops, journaling, or spending time with loved ones. We encourage students to check in regularly, whether with a trusted adult or their peers, to build stronger support systems.

Together, we can reduce the stigma surrounding mental health and empower youth to care for their whole well-being.

AANHPI Heritage Month:

May is also Asian American, Native Hawaiian, and Pacific Islander (AANHPI) Heritage Month, a time to celebrate AANHPI communities. Many students in our out-of-school time (OST) youth program come from various AANHPI backgrounds, making this month an opportunity to honor and uplift their identities, traditions, and experiences. Students will be encouraged to explore their own cultural identities while learning about others. Through SEL-focused activities, students will participate in cultural art projects, engage in discussions around representation, and share their communities' traditions.

We will encourage students to explore AANHPI histories and voices to reflect on the importance of representation. Whether through media, food, or conversations, students will have many ways to connect with different cultures.

PCDC's 60th Anniversary: SEL Workshop

In honor of PCDC's 60th Anniversary, students are participating in a special SEL workshop centered on reflection and growth. Inspired by PCDC's 60-year journey, students are creating visual versions of their own personal timelines while highlighting their experiences with PCDC. These timelines include moments such as volunteering, joining the OST program, participating in the summer C2L-PHL program, and how these experiences shape who they are today.



Through this activity, students reflect on their personal growth, exploring who they were when they first connected with PCDC and who they are becoming. To conclude the activity, students set a short-term goal for themselves such as preparing for college, focusing on exams, or working toward a personal goal for the summer. This reflection helps students identify their strengths and areas for growth.

VITA Tax Season Wrap-up: Thank You for an Incredible Year!

With the April 15th tax filing deadline passed, PCDC's Tax Year 2025 VITA program has closed. We want to give a huge shoutout to our amazing volunteers and dedicated staff for making this season such a success.

Here's what we accomplished:

- **783 clients served**
- **665 tax returns completed**
- **417 clients with limited English proficiency supported**
- **\$1,118,662 in total tax refunds secured**
- **\$562,042 in EITC received by our community**

Both our client numbers and total refund amounts increased from last year, reflecting the growing community trust and support. We are deeply grateful for the chance to serve you.

Housing and Family Services

PCDC Celebrates ESL Success at End-of-Semester Event

On April 23, PCDC held its ESL End-of-Semester Celebration at Crane, marking a significant milestone for our adult education program. This spring, 14 students successfully completed a 10-week semester, representing a wide age range from 24 to 70 and reflecting our diverse community. Feedback from participants was overwhelmingly positive, highlighting the instructors' commitment, the curriculum's effectiveness, and the strong sense of community. Overall, the program achieved its goals of enhancing English proficiency while creating a supportive learning atmosphere. Learners advanced through three ESL levels under the guidance of six dedicated instructors from the University of Pennsylvania's TESOL program.

PCDC is releasing registration information for the upcoming ESL semester. Classes will be offered every Monday and Wednesday. Community members interested in improving their English are encouraged to join us and continue their learning journey.



PCDC's April Program Highlights a Month of Growth and Community Impact!

April was another outstanding month for PCDC's Housing Counseling Program! On April 16th, our team hosted a bilingual homebuyer education workshop with 22 attendees. Additionally, 5 participants have scheduled one-on-one counseling sessions with our Housing Counselors as they continue their homeowner journey. If homeownership is your next goal or if you're searching for homebuyer grants, we'd love to connect with you!

PACE Program Prescription Assistance

Need help paying for prescription medications? The PACE Program may be able to assist. Pennsylvania residents age 65 and older may qualify for the PACE and PACENET programs, which provide low-cost prescription assistance. These programs work alongside Medicare and other drug coverage plans to significantly reduce out-of-pocket expenses. PACE PROGRAM PRESCRIPTION ASSISTANCE



WHAT IS PACE?

Pennsylvania's prescription assistance programs for older adults, PACE and PACENET, offer low-cost prescription medication to qualified residents, age 65 and older. The program works with Medicare Part D plans and other prescription drug plans such as retiree/union coverage, employer plans, Medicare Advantage (HMO, PPO) and Veterans' Benefits (VA) to lower out-of-pocket costs for medications.

AM I ELIGIBLE FOR PACE OR PACENET?

- Must be 65 or older
- A Pennsylvania resident for at least 90 days prior to the date of application
- You cannot be enrolled in the Department of Human Service's Medicaid prescription benefit
- Income requirements based on previous year gross income

PACE Income Limits

- For a single person, total income must be \$14,500 or less.
- For a married couple, combined total income must be \$17,700 or less.

PACENET Income Limits

- For a single person, total income can be between \$14,500 and \$33,500
- For a married couple, combined total income can be between \$17,700 and \$41,500

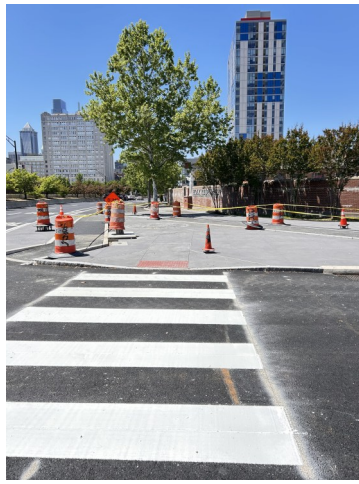
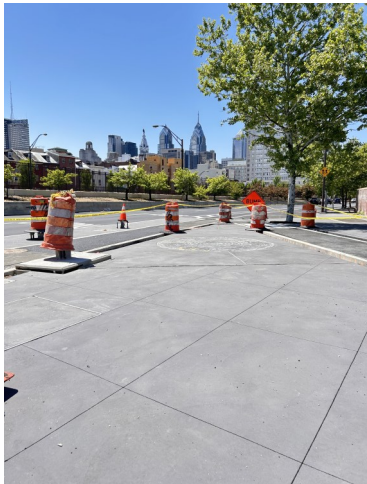

Vine Street Safety Project Nears Completion

PCDC is happy to report that the Vine Street Highway Safety Improvement Project (HSIP) is nearing completion. The construction along Vine Street from 7th to Broad is expected to create a safer Chinatown for pedestrians, cyclists, and drivers. These improvements will make navigating Chinatown a safer and more pleasant experience:

- Speed bumps and street markings to slow traffic in front of Holy Redeemer Elementary School and Roman Catholic High School;
- The redesign of the street and the addition of a traffic signal at 9th and Vine to slow traffic;
- The addition of bike lanes to give bikers a dedicated lane;
- On-street Parking spaces; and
- The elimination of two car lanes

Over several decades, PCDC secured funding and resources to implement phases of safety improvements. Each project improving the safety of crossing Vine Street Expressway makes Chinatown a safer place to live, work, and play. We are not done yet; Chinatown Stitch project plans are in the final design stage.



Zoning Matters

PCDC serves as Chinatown's RCO (Registered Community Organization). We meet on the second Tuesday of every other month: February, April, June, August, October, and December. All meetings begin at 6 PM. The RCO's boundaries are 7th to 13th Street and Filbert to Spring Garden Street.

WHAT IS PACE?

Pennsylvania's prescription assistance programs for older adults, PACE and PACENET, offer low-cost prescription medication to qualified residents, age 65 and older. The program works with Medicare Part D plans and other prescription drug plans such as retiree/union coverage, employer plans, Medicare Advantage (HMO, PPO) and Veterans' Benefits (VA) to lower out-of-pocket costs for medications.

AM I ELIGIBLE FOR PACE OR PACENET?

- Must be 65 or older
- A Pennsylvania resident for at least 90 days prior to the date of application
- You cannot be enrolled in the Department of Human Service's Medicaid prescription benefit
- Income requirements based on previous year gross income

PACE Income Limits

- For a single person, total income must be \$14,500 or less.
- For a married couple, combined total income must be \$17,700 or less.

PACENET Income Limits

- For a single person, total income can be between \$14,500 and \$33,500
- For a married couple, combined total income can be between \$17,700 and \$41,500

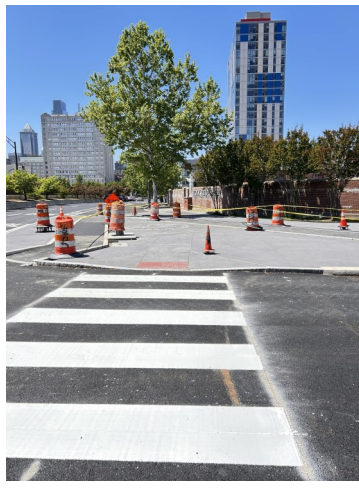
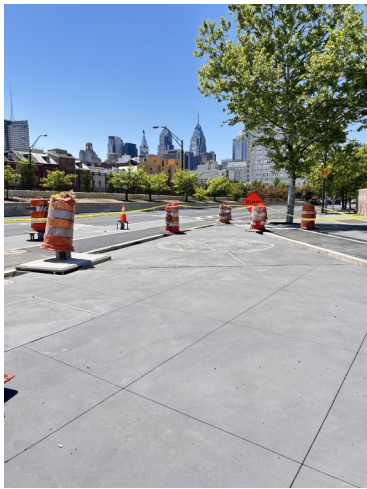
Vine Street 安全改善工程即將完工

PCDC 很高興宣布，Vine Street 公路安全改善計畫（HSIP）即將完工。從第 7 街至 Broad Street 的 Vine Street 改善工程，預計將為華埠的行人、自行車騎士與駕駛帶來更安全的交通環境。這些改善措施將讓大家在華埠通行時更加安全與舒適，包括：

- 於 Holy Redeemer Elementary School 與 Roman Catholic High School 前方增設減速丘與道路標線，以降低車速；
- 重新設計道路，並於第 9 街與 Vine Street 增設交通標誌，以減緩車流速度；
- 新增自行車道，提供單車騎士專用通行空間；
- 增設路邊停車位；
- 移除兩條汽車車道

數十年來，PCDC 持續爭取資金與資源，逐步推動各階段安全改善工程。每一項提升 Vine Street Expressway 周邊通行安全的計畫，都讓華埠成為更適合居住、工作與生活的社區。

我們的努力仍未停止，「縫合華埠項目」目前也已進入最終設計階段。

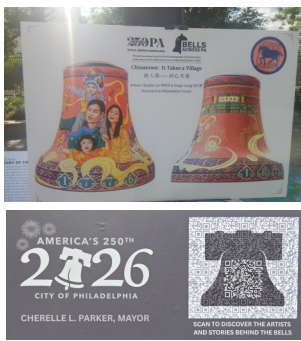
